



# **About ALSA**



#### NATIONAL CHAPTER INDONESIA

ALSA was originally named ASEAN Law Students' Association (ALSA). It was established on 18th of May, 1989, by a group of law students from ASEAN countries, specifically Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, and Thailand, and was formally agreed upon at the ALSA Conference 1989 in Jakarta. In 2003, ALSA expanded its scope to include other Asian countries and subsequently changed its name to the Asian Law Students' Association.

ALSA is a non-political and non-governmental organization consisting of 17 National Chapters. Specifically, ALSA Indonesia comprises 15 Local Chapters located in various public universities across Indonesia.

# LOCAL CHAPTER UNIVERSITAS SRIWIJAYA

The origin of ALSA Local Chapter Universitas Sriwijaya stem from the realization of the importance of building a shared legal perspective among ASEAN countries. In 1999, the Faculty of Law at Universitas Sriwijaya (Unsri) responded to an invitation to attend the Regional ALSA Conference for ASEAN level, which was held at Universitas Indonesia (UI) in Jakarta, Indonesia. Unsri appointed two

representatives from its Faculty of Law, namely Dr. Mada Apriandi Zuhir, S.H., M.C.L., and Dr. Meria Utama, S.H., L.L.M., who also served as the initiators of the establishment of ALSA LC Unsri. On 21st of March 2001, during Musyawarah Nasional VIII ALSA held at Universitas Padjadjaran (Unpad) in Bandung, Universitas Sriwijaya was officially designated as a Local Chapter of ALSA Indonesia. To this day, ALSA LC Unsri continues to progress actively, remains highly sought after by law students, and consistently strives to develop members and alumni of outstanding quality.

#### **ALSA English Camp (E-Camp)**



ALSA English Camp (E-Camp) is a program organized to enhance English proficiency among members of ALSA LC Unsri. Held in the format of a "camping" activity, it offers participants an immersive English learning experience. ALSA English Camp is designed to develop public speaking skills, build teamwork, and foster emotional bonding among participants.

#### **ALSA Mooting Class**



ALSA Mooting Class is an annual program of ALSA LC Unsri organized to embody two of ALSA's pillars, Academically Committed and Legally Skilled. This program consists of two main activities, a seminar and a moot court workshop.

#### **ALSA Visit**



ALSA Visit is an activity focused on enhancing the visibility and engagement of ALSA Local Chapter Universitas Sriwijaya through visits to both governmental and private institutions, featuring discussions on legal issues related to the institutions visited.

#### **ALSA International Video Conference**



ALSA International Video Conference is a program organized to address prominent legal issues by inviting experienced professionals in their respective fields to speak at a seminar. This activity also involves collaboration with relevant organizations, Local Chapters, and National Chapters within ALSA to participate in a Focus Group

Discussion and share their perspectives and insights on the selected legal topic.

#### **ALSA Care and Legal Coaching Clinic**



ALSA Care and Legal Coaching Clinic is a program grounded on one of ALSA's pillars, Socially Responsible. It is essentially designed to deliver both humanitarian values and legal education to the community as a way to strengthen ALSA's social impact.








ALSA Journey Magazine is a program dedicated to publishing a magazine that features a blend of general content and light legal discussions, with themes selected to remain flexible.
